EE is pleased to announce the presentation of an enhanced oil recovery (EOR) workshop for professional and technical personnel of CNPC Jilin Oil Field.

Enviro Energy International Holdings Limited (“**Company**” or “**EE**”) is pleased to announce the presentation of an enhanced oil recovery (“**EOR**”) workshop to be provided by CCST Singapore Pte. Ltd. (“**CCST**”), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company to professional and technical personnel of China National Petroleum Corporation (“**CNPC**”) Jilin Oil Field as part of the Company's ongoing plans and activities related to new enhanced hydrocarbon recovery investments. EE continues to evaluate prospective investments throughout Asia Pacific and technical collaboration in China is one ongoing aspect of its business plans.

Mr. Wong Sum Lok Sam, Senior Vice President of CCST, led the discussions of EOR requirements of the workshop and CCST will provide the principal technical and engineering resources as well as funding support additional to the CAPC’s main support.

EE’s technical expertise will be delivered by Mr. Derril Stephenson, President of Vikor Energy Inc. When he was with Vikor Resources Ltd., Mr. Stephenson led the EOR operations at Joffre near Red Deer, Alberta utilising carbon dioxide (“**CO₂**”) from the NOVA Chemicals’ Joffre manufacturing facility.

CCST is the Singapore-incorporated subsidiary of EE which has the mission to advance unconventional energy development including enhanced hydrocarbon production. Technology development and application in the areas of petroleum and natural gas are of particular interest and a number of project concepts are currently under review. Underground coal gasification and technologies utilising CO₂ are among those being considered.

EE holds a 50% interest in two conventional petroleum production operations in Jilin, both of which are operated by PetroChina Company Limited, a subsidiary of CNPC.
